

## CLEVER R-V INCLEMENT WEATHER OPTIONS

Should we have Snow, Ice or Extreme Cold the Clever R-V Administration will utilize the following options for student safety.

### 1. Normal School Day

- If, in the opinion of the Superintendent, or designee, the roads are clear enough that the buses can safely deliver students to school we will have school as normal.
- Parents are asked to alert their Bus Driver to let them know if their lane is unsafe for a school bus. Parents may also call the Central Office (743-4800) beginning at 6:30 AM and the office personnel will contact the driver on the radio.
- Parents will ultimately decide if it is safe for their student to travel or not and thus may keep their student home if they prefer.
- Those students must bring a note from the parent when they return to school in order for the absence to be excused.

### 2. Two Hour Late Start

- Many times when traffic clears and the sun and snowplows get out, area roads can become much safer. If the Superintendent, or designee, believes that an extra two hours will improve conditions sufficiently to hold school, then a Late Start will be announced both to the media and via School Messenger.
- Buses will run their regular routes two hours later than normal unless we are notified by the parents as above.
- All staff will report at their regular time while still being as safe as possible. Should staff members not be able to travel they are required to call their Building Principal or Supervisor as soon as possible to make arrangements to be picked up or excused.
- Parents who drop their children off on their way to work may continue to do so. Parents who would normally bring their children are asked not to deliver the children until the two hour late start time.
- There will be no hot breakfast on Late Start days but cereal, juice, etc. will be available as usual.
- Bell schedules will be adjusted accordingly to provide time in each class and schools will dismiss at the regularly scheduled times.

### 3. Early Dismissal

- If, in the opinion of the Superintendent, or designee, the weather and /or roads deteriorate to the point that the buses cannot safely deliver students we will cancel school for the balance of the day.
- Early dismissals cannot have a set time since they are weather dependent but if we attend three hours the day does not have to be made up.
- Every effort will be made to hold the students through their lunch period.
- Early dismissals will be announced both to the media and via School Messenger.
- Early dismissal is a last resort in consideration of parents' work schedules, but they may be used in an emergency.

### 4. Cancel School Day

- If, in the opinion of the Superintendent, or designee, the roads are not clear enough that the buses can safely deliver students, we will cancel school for the entire day.
- School closings will be announced both to the media and via School Messenger.
- If at all possible school cancellation announcements will be made in the evening prior to the school day.
